A message from the Chair of the Board

The Montreal Heart Institute is more than a hospital. It's a one-of-a-kind, specialized institute that is completely dedicated to tackling tangible problems that affect us all, whether directly or indirectly.

It is also a visionary organization that leverages technological progress to care for sensitive hearts. It is a place where donations dedicated to research turn into services for patients, improved treatments, medical advances, and scientific breakthroughs.

As a leader in the field, the MHI continues to pave the way for the medicine of the future — both here and abroad. In fact, more than 600 specialists from across the world have come to the Institute for training.

The MHI also stands out as an incubator for novel ideas that turn into major medical projects.

This year, the MHI acquired seven new cardiopulmonary bypass (CPB) machines, also known as heart-lung machines, that enable teams to safely stop a patient's heart during open-heart surgery. The machines have been successfully used in 1,717 heart surgeries. The goal is now to perform 2,500 surgeries every year with this equipment.

In 2023-2024, the MHI performed 325 surgeries using a robotic-assisted system. In fact, the MHI is the only centre in Canada equipped with the Da Vinci Xi surgical system. It is used to carry out minimally invasive surgeries that reduce the risk of complications, shorten hospital stays, speed up recovery times, and reduce post-surgery pain.

And this is only the beginning because the future is extremely bright.

Thank you for standing by our side in our never-ending quest to making a world without a disease. Thank you for feeding the fire that fuels us in our mission to always save more lives.

RESEARCH

Transforming research into hope for patients

Donations dedicated to research are powerful levers that transform patient care and push the boundaries of cardiovascular medicine.

The Dal-GenE-2 study explores the potential of a precision medicine, dalcetrapib, in reducing the number of cardiovascular events in patients with a specific genetic profile. This pioneer project is carried out in 32 countries and could change how acute coronary syndrome is managed.

In parallel, the COLCOT-T2D study, which aims to recruit 10,000 patients with diabetes, explores the potential of colchicine to prevent heart disease and cognitive impairment. Colchicine is inexpensive and has the potential to be extremely effective. In other words, it could change the lives of millions of people.

At the MHI, every scientific breakthrough has a direct impact on the lives of patients.





PREVENTION

A summary of the COVÉPIC project

The COVÉPIC project, initiated by the EPIC Centre during the COVID-19 pandemic, allowed more than 200 adults aged 50 and over to take advantage of cognitive and exercise training programs from the comfort of their own home.

In August 2022, the project demonstrated the feasibility and efficiency of these online programs. Moreover, the dropout rate was remarkably low (5%). On the back of this success, the COVÉPIC project entered its second phase in 2023 with the goal of creating a smart digital platform. The platform was delivered in November and it used AI to tailor training programs to each participant's needs.

The program is available for free online to participants from a variety of geographic areas. It can therefore provide those living in remote areas with a program focused on prevention.

EDUCATION

Simulation programs to better understand the heart

The Montreal Heart Institute is synonymous with innovation. Thanks to our cutting-edge cardiac simulation training programs, our residents and health care professionals are able to transform every heartbeat. Under Dr. Nicolas Thibodeau-Jarry, these programs accelerate the pace of learning. Participants take less time to master the skills essential to saving lives. Greater expertise means a greater potential to save lives.

With its new simulators, the MHI is extending its influence and will continue to have a greater impact on members and on future leaders in the field of cardiology. Ambitious projects, such as a virtual simulation of cardiogenic shock, are making the MHI a global leader in education techniques.

The lessons learned result in more effective, more human-centric patient care, thereby ensuring a safer, healthier future for all. The MHI doesn't just follow the beat — it defines it.


